We would love to have horse/riders, buggies/teams, etc.

A parade would not be complete without fire trucks, police department representatives, and dignitaries from each city in the county. We invite all to honor us with their participation.

Parade Time:	9:30 a.m., Saturday, June 5, 2010
Place:	Downtown Snook
Check-in:	8:30 a.m.-9:00 a.m. (location to be announced at a later date)
In line:	9:00 a.m.
Judging:	9:00 a.m. (winners will be identified prior to start of parade)
Parade starts:	9:30 a.m.

## SNOOK FEST PARADE RULES

### **NO ENTRY FEE REQUIRED.**

Entries are placed in order by category as determined by parade chairman.

PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED TO FLOAT ENTRIES BEST PORTRAYING THIS YEAR'S THEME—

First - \$100; Second - \$75.00; Third -- \$50

### **Participants in the Snook Fest Parade must comply with the following rules:**

- 1) Complete entry form and return it by date cited on cover letter.
- 2) DO NOT THROW objects of any kind, including but not limited to candy, gum, balloons, toys, confetti, etc from the parade entry.
- 3) Public officials must provide their own vehicle.
- 4) Entries must be checked in and in place by 9 a.m.
- 5) All entries must provide their own sign for identification in the parade.
- 6) All participants must conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted.
- 7) To limit the number of vehicles in the lineup area, only parade participants are permitted in the area.
- 8) Horses must be controlled at all times in the lineup area before and during the parade; if not, they will not be allowed to enter in the parade.
- 9) NO ANIMALS FROM PARADE ARE PERMITTED IN PARK AFTER THE PARADE.
- 10) No fertilizer or chemical tanks are permitted in parade.
- 11) Entries must be low and remain so to pass under utility wires.
- 12) An adult MUST accompany children participants.
- 13) Upon completion of parade route, turn right on park road and continue past the water well building on right to the baseball field on the left; turn around and wait until parade is totally completed. Special Parking Areas will be designated at the City Park for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place floats. All others should disband and park in designated festival parking areas.
